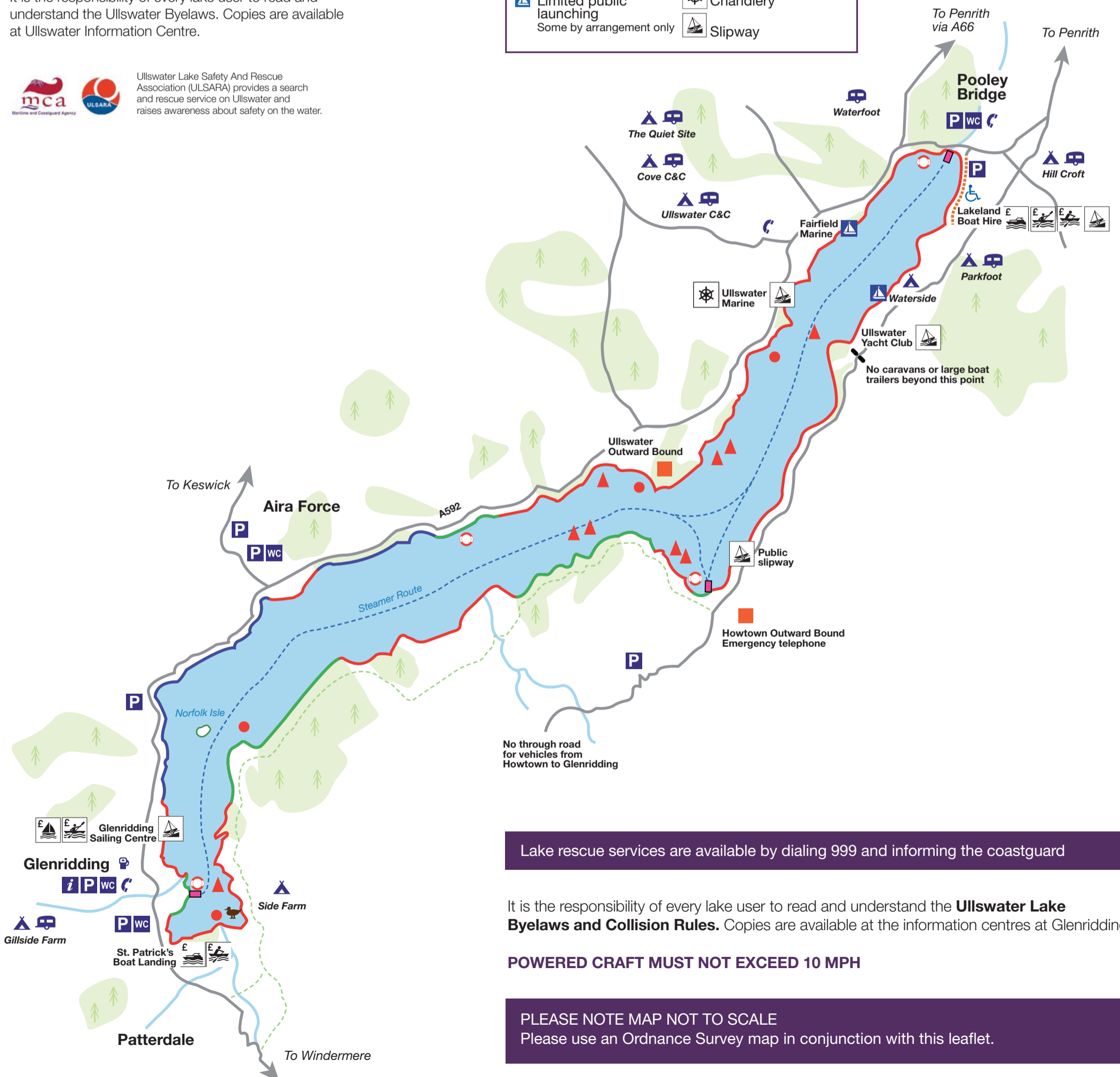
Ullswater Lake Safety And Rescue Association (ULSARA) provides a search and rescue service on Ullswater and raises awareness about safety on the water.
